DMTA Recital Series 2018-2019 Dates

Each school year, DMTA provides a unique opportunity for our students. Four times during the fall and spring, a recital is held in which students of all ages may participate. It is an excellent opportunity for students to perform for an appreciative and friendly audience. The programs usually last from 45 minutes to an hour and the dates are chosen to provide "performance practice" for students who are preparing for other events—festivals, competitions, etc.

The recitals are held at King of Glory Lutheran Church on LBJ Freeway—a central location with an excellent Steinway piano and a hall with stadium seating and an intimate feel.

The first two recitals have already been held, but there are two remaining for school-age students, February 3rd and April 7th. A recital for adult students comes on May 4th at Steinway Hall on North Central Expressway.
